Photoshop CS 4

- More tools and features that work with 16 bit & 32 bit images
 - 8 bit (256 shades X 3 colors=16 million shades)
 - 16 bit (65,000 shades X 3 colors= 42,250,000 shades)
- CMYK and LAB color modes
- HDR Imaging
- Channels Palette (great when using two monitors)
- Record custom Actions
- Layer Masks, Layer Comps and Quick Mask
- Smart Objects and Smart Guides
- Pen Tool and Paths palette
- Editing History Log
- Advanced color management
- Advanced Web features

Photoshop CS4

- Bridge
 - More advanced features than Elements Organizer
 - More control for RAW files
 - Batch Processing of images
 - Record Batch Actions
